



GENERAL INFORMATION

By handling your new upholstery fabric with care, you can make a decisive contribution to preserving its original beauty. Please note the following recommendations:

- Avoid exposing your new upholstered furniture to direct sunlight.
- If possible, do not place your new upholstered furniture directly next to a radiator.
- Avoid contact between rough clothing and your upholstered furniture.
- Do not use strong cleaning agents, hand sanitizers or acetone. These cause immediate damage and contribute to the deterioration of the material. The use of such cleaning agents is at the owner's risk.

Artificial leather is also known as textile leather. This is a type of fabric that is covered with a thin layer of plastic. The difference to real leather is hardly recognizable nowadays. As the surface is often grained, the faux leather feels just like the texture of real leather.

Another major advantage of faux leather is that the material is very easy to clean. This insensitivity to dirt makes artificial leather an ideal upholstery material.

REGULAR CLEANING

- Approximately every two weeks
- Clean upholstered furniture with a dust cloth. If necessary, moisten the cloth slightly and add mild soapy water.
- Use a cleaning brush for vacuuming.

STAIN REMOVAL

General information

- The quicker you react, the easier it is to remove stains.
- When cleaning upholstered furniture, test the care or household products on an inconspicuous area beforehand and follow the manufacturer's dosage instructions.
- Dabbing is better than rubbing to prevent the fabric from lightening.

What do I need to remove stains?

- Mild soapy water
- Sponge (for light to medium soiling)
- Soft hand brush (for heavy soiling)
- Light-colored, clean microfiber or cotton cloth
- Distilled water

Cleaning procedure

1. Remove stains with a wet cloth in circular movements.
2. In addition, dissolve mild soap suds in lukewarm water and apply with a soft cloth/sponge.
3. A soft brush can also be used for stubborn stains.
4. Then wipe the artificial leather with a cloth and clean water and leave to dry.

INTENSIVE CARE

Clean the surface of the upholstered furniture thoroughly before intensive care. Otherwise the dirt will set in and the care products will not work optimally.

- Once or twice a year
- Use artificial leather balm. Do not use products for natural leather as these can attack the surface of the artificial leather.
- Using the artificial leather balm prevents the leather from drying out and becoming brittle.
